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Walk among the giants of the forest

1 Tahune AirWalk
Walk above the forest canopy – share the lives of the forest giants from up-close – look down from high to the place where the wild waters of the Huon and Picton Rivers mingle. The 600-metre walkway ends at a spectacular cantilevered platform, 50 metres above the riverbank.

2 Eagle Hang Gliding
Soar like an eagle from a lofty perch high in the treetops – feel the wind beneath your wings as you dip and swoop on a thrilling 450-metre return glide across the Huon River. The flight is exciting – and cable-controlled for safety. No pilot's licence needed!

3 Twin Rivers Adventure
Here's an amazing new way to discover Tasmania's spectacular wild places – drifting gently through quiet stretches of the Picton and Huon Rivers on a raft or kayak. The two-hour trip of safe and comfortable drifting on the river – it's an experience that everyone* can enjoy.

4 Huon Pine Walk
Enjoy this picturesque, short and easy walking track along the forested banks of the Huon River, its dark, tannin-coloured waters flowing from buttongrass plains in the World Heritage Area. See, touch and smell the ancient Huon pines that grow along the 20-minute loop walk.

5 Swinging Bridges Walk
This three-kilometre track crosses the Huon and Picton Rivers. Pause at the viewing platform where the rivers meet. Discover the ruins of Constable Francis McPartlan's 1870s house. Imagine living here alone, deep in the wilderness.

6 Visitor centre and licensed cafe
Take a break to enjoy local specialties. Try salmon and honey – taste the Huon Valley's cool-climate wines and local cider. Pause for a snack, light meal, tea, coffee or ice cream. Browse in the gift shop for a unique Huon pine memento.

7 Bluestone Shelter
Learn more about the fascinating history and natural heritage of Tasmania's far southern region. Meet an interpretive guide to discover the stories of the pioneers who lived and worked in the forests and on the rivers.

8 Accommodation
Stay a night or two and enjoy an owl's eye experience of the AirWalk by torchlight. Choose The Lodge, for families, couples or groups; Tahune Cabin's cosy, self-contained two-bedroom accommodation; or the RV and caravan sites, free with ticket purchase.
